SAIGON, NOV. 13 (UPI) -- SOUTH VIETNAMESE ARMY AND MILITIAMEN SHOT IT OUT IN AN ARGEUMENT ALST NIGHT AND TWO U.S. SERVICEMEN BYSTANDERS WERE WOUNDED 'N THE SHOOTING, REPORTS FROM THE TOWN OF AN LOC SAID TODAY.

THE REPORTS SAID GOVERNMENT ARMY CAVALRYMEN FOUGHT WITH MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH VI TNAMESE CIVILIAN IRREGULAR DEFENSE

GROUP AT THE TOWN 62 MILES NORTH OF SAIGON.

THERE WERE NO IMMED ATE REPORTS ON VIETNAMESE CASUALTIES.
BUT THE REPORTS SAID THE TWO INJURED AMERICANS WERE NOT
DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN THE ARGUEMENT THAT PRECEDED THE
GUNFIRE.

THIS MARKED A REL TIVELY RARE OUTBREAK OF WIOLENCE IN SOUTH VEITNAM'S OCCASIONAL INTER-SERVICE RIVALRY.
